








DELTOID INTRAMUSCULAR







Injection angle: 90°

Max volume: 1 mL (recommended). [Can go up to 2 mL

depending on body habitus.]

Steps to find the injection site:

- 1. Find the knobby top of the acromion process
- 2. Imagine the base of an inverted triangle starting two finger widths below the acromion process (see picture on the right)
- 3. Give the injection in the center of the inverted triangle, into the deltoid muscle

Aspiration Method: Pull back plunger to check for blood before injecting. [This is advised by FDA for certain injectable medications.]

Z-Track Method: Displace skin layer before injecting to contain injected medication below subcutaneous layer and in the intended muscle.
